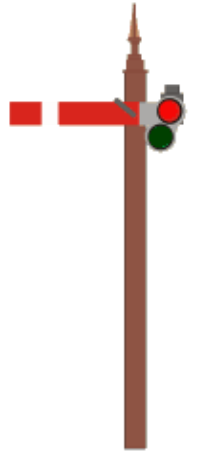

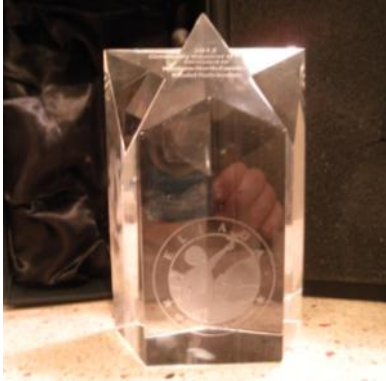
September 22. The town of **Old Fort** is paying tribute to **Andrews Geyser** with events at the depot and at the geyser. See story about the geyser on the [following page](#).

Andrews Geyser. The geyser, built in 1879, was man-made and positioned next to Mill Creek. It was a popular tourist attraction, particularly eye-catching for railroad passengers ascending the nine miles of track and tunnels that peaked at the top of Swannanoa Gap.

In 1903, the Round Knob Hotel burned. The geyser was relocated, restored and named for Alexander Boyd Andrews, a North Carolina native and Vice President of the Western North Carolina Railroad and , and one of the *men responsible for the construction of the railroad between Old Fort and Asheville, North Carolina*, in the late 19th century.

The fountain was constructed as a tribute to the approximately 120 men who died building the railroad through this particularly treacherous stretch of land that culminates with the crossing of the Eastern Continental Divide through the Swannanoa Tunnel. The fountain was said to be eye-catching for railroad passengers ascending the 13 miles of track and seven tunnels that peaks at the top of Swannanoa Gap because it could be seen several times long the route.

OCTOBER MEETING LAYOUT PLAN CHALLENGE

The challenge is to plan a layout that meets the minimum size for scenery and civil AP certificates.

Scenery AP requirements:

O scale 60 square feet
HO scale 32 square feet
N scale 18 square feet
Other scales in proportional relationship to HO scale.

Electrical

Prepare a schematic of the model railroad showing gaps, blocks, feeder, power supplies, etc.

Bring your layout drawing to the meeting, or bring them as a PDF JPG, PNG format to show on the screen.

Civil requirements:

O scale 75 feet of track HO or S scale 50 feet of track
N, Z, TT scale 25 feet of track

- Plan must have adequate terminal facilities for freight and/or passenger cars
- Terminal facility for storage and service of motive power
- Minimum of one mainline passing siding
- 4 switching locations, not counting yards, interchanges, wye, & reversing loops
- Provision for turning motive power
- Simultaneous operations of at least 2 trains in either direction
- Six of the following examples:

Passing siding	Spur	Crossover
Reversing loop	Wye	Simple ladder (3 track minimum)
Compound ladder	Turntable	Transfer Table
Super Elevation	Simple/Compound Overhead wire	
Scale Track	Coal Dump	Ash Pit
Cog Railway	Service Pit	Grade Elevation
